ORDINANCE NO. 10-05

An Ordinance Amending Title 10.52.060 Of The Harwood Heights Code Of Ordinances Concerning Parking In Residential Districts

WHEREAS, the Village of Harwood Heights is a home rule unit of government pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Illinois Constitution; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to its home rule power, the Village may exercise any power and perform any function relating to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village find it to be in the best interests of the Village to establish additional restrictions on street parking within the residential districts of the Village, as set forth in this Ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Harwood Heights, County of Cook, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

SECTION 2. Amendment. Section 10.52.060 of the Village Code of Ordinances shall be and hereby is amended to read as follows, with changes to the existing code noted in **bolded and underlined letters**:

10.52.060 Stopping, standing or parking prohibited.

It is unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to stop, stand or park such vehicle in any of the following places, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with directions of a police officer or an official traffic sign or signal. Any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this section shall be fined fifty dollars (\$50.00) per occurrence.

- A. Within an intersection;
- B. On a crosswalk;
- C. Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within thirty (30) feet of a point on the curb immediately opposite the end of a safety zone;
- D. Within thirty (30) feet of an official traffic signal or stop sign on the approaching side;
- E. Within twenty (20) feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;
- F. At any curb within fifteen (15) feet of a fire hydrant;
- G. At any place within twenty (20) feet of the entrance to any fire station, and on the side of any street opposite the entrance to any fire station within seventy five (75) feet of the entrance;
- H. At any place where the standing of any vehicle will block the use of any driveway **or otherwise encroach upon the paved boundaries of all driveways located in the residential districts within the village.**

- I. Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when such stopping, standing or parking would obstruct traffic;
- J. On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street;
- K. At any place where official traffic signs have been erected prohibiting stopping, standing or parking;
- L. Within eighty (80) feet of a bus stop;
- M. In any alley within twenty (20) feet of the inner sidewalk line projected across such alley;
- N. Under the lowest portion of any fire escape;
- O. Upon any parkway except in case of emergency;
- P. On a sidewalk;
- Q. More than twelve (12) inches from the curb;
- R. Parked facing the wrong way;
- S. Parked longer than the time stated on the sign;
- T. Parked in a lot anywhere other than in a clearly marked parking space;
- U. No person shall stop, stand, or park a minivan, van or truck within thirty (30) feet of a crosswalk where posted;
- V. Parking shall not be permitted along Illinois Route 43 from the South Corporate Limit to the North Corporate Limit within the village.

SECTION 3. Resolution of Conflicts. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. Savings Clause. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. The Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.




