Male, Female and Unified Partners

**Group 1 Registration @ 5:30pm:**

- Ages 5-8 years
- Ages 9-12 year
- Ages 13-16 years

**Group 2 Registration @ 6:30pm:**

- Ages 17-20 years
- Ages 21+ years
- Unified Partners (any age)

**Rules: Male and Female Free Throw Competition**

Contestants in each division will attempt ten shots from any of the designated free throw lines. Each basket made is worth different points based on difficulty level. The contestants with the most points in each division will be declared the winners. Tie breakers will be decided by the best of five shoot out; contestant may choose where to shoot.

**Rules: Unified Partners Free Throw Competition**

\*Partner + Contestant with special needs\*

Contestants in the Unified division share ten free throw shots from any of the designated free throw lines with their Unified Partner. A minimum of two shots must be attempted by the unified partner with special needs. Each basket made is worth different points based on difficulty level. Tie breakers will be decided by the best of five shoot out; contestant may choose where to shoot and a minimum of one shot must be attempted by the unified partner with special needs.

**Regulations:**

A participation waiver will be required at the door. Space is limited, so sign up today!
