ORDINANCE NO. 10-06

An Ordinance Amending Title 2.12.180 of the Harwood Heights Code Of Ordinances Concerning Committee of the Whole Meetings

WHEREAS, the Village of Harwood Heights is a home rule unit of government pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Illinois Constitution; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to its home rule power, the Village may exercise any power and perform any function relating to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village find it to be in the best interests of the Village to change the regular monthly meeting day from the first Wednesday of the month to the first Thursday of the month, as set forth in this Ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Harwood Heights, County of Cook, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

SECTION 2. Amendment. Section 2.12.180 of the Village Code of Ordinances shall be and hereby is amended to read as follows, with changes to the existing code noted in **bolded and underlined letters** and deleted language ~~struck-out~~:

2.12.180 Committee of the whole.

The mayor and board of trustees shall hold committee of the whole meetings on the first ~~Wednesday~~ **Thursday** of each month at seven p.m. Additional meetings of the committee of the whole prior may be called by the mayor or three trustees when deemed necessary. When the board meets as a committee of the whole, without objection, the president shall continue to serve, otherwise the board shall appoint a chairperson to preside, and the presiding officer of the board shall leave the chair. The rules of the board as far as applicable shall be observed in the committee of the whole, except that no limit shall be placed on the frequency of speaking. Minutes of the committee of the whole should be approved within a reasonable time after the meeting and are to be included on the agenda for approval at the next committee of the whole meeting.

SECTION 3. Resolution of Conflicts. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. Savings Clause. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.


SECTION 5. Effective Date. The Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


