QUALIFICATIONS

- Must have completed the State of Illinois certified police officer training board requirements and be currently serving or have served in the last 6 months previous to application as a sworn police officer for an Illinois city/municipality or State Police. Applicants must be in good standing with the agency they currently serve.
- Be a United States citizen.
- Applicants shall be between 21- 35 years of age at time of application
- Education – Bachelor or Associate's Degree in any field of study (OR 60 credit hours at an accredited college or university).
- Valid Driver's License.
- Must agree to comply with all requirements of the position and have the ability to pass all examination and training requirements, including but not limited to: background investigation, psychological and medical examination, etc.
- Ability to furnish upon request, a copy of the following, to the extent applicable: a resume; professional licenses; training certificates; naval or military service board and discharge papers (DD-214/Copy 4); documents confirming work experience; birth certificate; college transcripts; last two employee evaluations; two police reports demonstrating best work and any other employment related material as requested or required.
- Applicants must furnish copy of power test card taken in the last 6 months

Selection Process:

Each phase of the process is pass/fail and required to proceed to the next.

- Pre-screening application review by Police Department Command Staff and Police Commission
- Selected applicants will interview with the Board of Police Commissioners and Police Command Staff
- Character and background investigation and credit check
- Polygraph examination
- Post-offer examinations including, but not limited to: psychological evaluation, medical examination, vision screening, and drug use screening
- All appointments are subject to a probationary period
