## LABORER

The Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago is preparing to hire a small number of laborers over the next four years. These jobs are at plants in Cook County that treat sewage. There are no jobs in downtown Chicago. People in these jobs may work in unpleasant surroundings and be exposed to unpleasant odors.

You will have to give your Social Security number when you apply. You must be 18 years old by July 24, 2011.

### How we will hire people:

1. As previously announced, the Illinois State Lottery Pick 4 game (evening) from Sunday, May 22, 2011 was used to get the numbers for the Laborer lottery list. (The Illinois State Lottery has no interest in the way the District hires people.)
2. The winning numbers are 9918.
3. If the last four digits of your Social Security number are between 9918 and 9999 or between 0000 and 0418, you will have until June 24, 2011 to file an application for Laborer.
4. You must fill out an application in person by June 24, 2011, at the Employment Service Office, 100 E. Erie St., Chicago. The Employment Service Office will accept applications from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on weekdays only. Applications will not be mailed or emailed and will not be accepted by mail or email.
5. We will not accept applications from anyone whose numbers do not come between 9918 and 9999 or between 0000 and 0418. You must show us your picture ID and Social Security card to prove you have one of the winning numbers. No one else can file your application for you.
6. Ties will be broken by the first five digits of your Social Security number, in reverse order, from lowest to highest.
7. If you get on the lottery list, you will be asked to take a basic skills written test. You will receive a letter notifying you of your rank on the list and providing information regarding the basic skills written test.
8. If you pass the test, you will be eligible for hire as a Laborer.
9. If you are offered a job, you will take a physical exam that includes a drug test and an evaluation of your ability to meet the specific physical demands of the job.
10. If you are hired, you will have a six-month probation. The District can extend it to 12 months.
11. If you are hired, you must have a valid Illinois driver's license before you finish probation.
12. If you are hired, you must live in the boundaries of the District within six months of completing probation. (The District covers about 90% of Cook County.)

The current hourly rate for a Maintenance Laborer B is \$22.89. Other Laborer jobs may be filled from this list.
