Property Taxes

Real Estate Property tax payments have been extended to **October 1st** without penalty.

Covid Testing - Nasal Swabs

The Illinois Department of Public Health sponsors a testing site at 6959 Forest Preserve Drive, 7 days a week, 7:00 am-3:00 pm. Testing is provided at no charge; appointment and insurance are not required. Parent or Guardian required for those under age 18. Results are obtained within 4-7 days. You will receive a call, but results are not left on voicemail so you need to call back.

There were 65 orders, so please be patient as staff is scheduled and assigned. We want to thank Morton Arboretum for partnering with us to provide these trees at no charge to our residents.

September 30th is the deadline!!!

Let's make Harwood Heights count!

We're getting closer. We are at 71% - We are aiming at a 100% participation.

Your form has been mailed to you but you can easily get counted online at www.my2020census.gov, by phone (844-330-2020), or by mail. It asks just a few simple questions. Be sure to include everyone in your household living with you since April 1, 2020, no matter their age, gender or citizenship. Your information cannot be shared with any other agency.

Its purpose is to provide data that will affect funding for our community and also impact Federal and State representation.

Board of Review "Drive Thru" for Tax Appeals

Wednesday, September 23 at Union Ridge from 5:00-7:00 pm

The Board of Review will be open for appeals in September for you to file your tax appeals.

- 1) You can file your appeal online at:

- 2) You can drive through Union Ridge parking lot for assistance.
Simply obtain a form as you enter one of the parking lots, park, fill it out, get questions answered, and return the form as you exit.
- 3) You can also obtain an Appeal Form from the Village Hall, but be sure to return them to the Village Hall by 5:00 pm on September 24th.
