Early voting at this location is for registered Suburban Cook County voters only.

COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS & REQUIREMENTS:

ALL VOTERS MUST HAVE A FACE COVERING OVER THEIR NOSE AND MOUTH BEFORE ENTERING VILLAGE HALL. TEMPERATURE CHECKS WILL BE CONDUCTED UPON ENTERING. MACHINES WILL BE SANITIZED AFTER EACH USE. 6-FOOT SOCIAL DISTANCING WILL BE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES. DUE TO CAPACITY LIMITATIONS, YOU MAY BE REQUIRED TO WAIT OUTSIDE UNTIL A VOTING MACHINE BECOMES AVAILABLE.

For those who have requested a mail-in ballot - For the first time ever, the Clerk's Office will offer **secure mail ballot drop boxes** at Early Voting locations. These mail ballot drop boxes will be staffed by Cook County Clerk employees and will be emptied every day.
