Covid Vaccines

Have you received your Covid vaccine? It is getting easier to obtain an appointment.

Those with computers, log on to: <https://coronavirus.illinois.gov/s/vaccination-location>

Put in your zip code, enter, and select the closest location. Click to the right of that location to see if an appointment can be made.

For those that are home bound, vaccines may be available by calling the Cook County hotline at: 1-833-308-1988. An operator will take your information and contact you when an appointment is scheduled.

After you had your vaccine, please continue to wear face masks and do your part with washing hands, surfaces, etc.

1. Make a Police report
2. Advise your Employer
3. Contact IDES Illinois Department of Employment Security 800-814-0513 (Be patient as call volumes are high) (www.identitytheft.gov)
4. Do NOT activate the debit card if you received one.
5. Review your credit reports to check for any fraudulent activity.

Another reminder...Please be good neighbors and pick up after your pets. Let's
keep our neighborhood clean and respect our neighbors. Also pets must be on a
leash when walking your dog.

Cat & Dog license:

Don't forget to get a Cat & Dog license tag. The cost is \$2.00 to register.
Please bring proof of rabies vaccine to obtain your tag.

Prescription Drugs

If you have any unused medications, DO NOT flush them down the
toilet or dispose of them in the sink. It contaminates our water system.
You can properly dispose of your medications at our Police Department.
A drop box is located in their lobby. Simply remove your information
from the containers.

Secretary of State Office:

All driver's license and ID card expiration dates are extended to August
1st, 2021 but not to commercial licenses.

In addition, license plate stickers can be purchased on-line. You may use
the receipt as proof of registration compliance for no more than 30 days
from the expiration of the previous license plate registration sticker date.
