Tax Appeal Seminar - Assessor's office Thursday, July 21 - 6:00 pm - 7:30 pm

Recently the county released the initial assessment of properties in Norwood Park Township. They follow a triennial cycle which means one-third of the county is reassessed every three years. Please review your assessment and if incorrect or the market value is more than what it should be, property owners could file an appeal.

The Village will host a Tax Appeal Seminar with members of the Tax Assessor's Office of Fritz Kaegi along with Commissioner Peter Silvestri, State Representative Brad Stephens and State Senator Rob Martwick.
