Don't be a hero - leave it up to the Police

With the threat of theft around our community, we want to inform you of some safety measures you can take:

- ♦ Report any suspicious activity/people to Police. Our Police Department will respond to all calls.
- ♦ Catalytic Converter Theft Never engage a catalytic converter thief. Value your life over all property. Do not put yourself at risk, Call Police (911).
- ♦ General Safety Be aware of your surroundings at all times when walking or driving. We can all limit crimes of opportunity by being extra vigiliant.
- ♦ Don't be distracted by your phones. Criminals will see this and take advantage of it.

Post Office Issues

Mail service has been awful. Late deliveries. No deliveries for days or weeks and now...white washing of checks that you mailed when paying bills. We want to make everyone aware of this scam, giving you suggestions how to help avoid this new wave of mail fraud. White-washing is when mail is stolen from the mailbox and your check is altered (white washed) and money is taken from your bank account. Here are some safety tips:

♦ Make a police report as soon as you discover your check amount and payee was improperly changed and cashed.

Mail bills and letters directly inside the post office facility.

♦ Put mail in mailboxes just before pick-up. Don't put mail into mailboxes after the posted pick-up time. Avoid leaving mail in the boxes overnight.

• Pay bills on-line or through your bank with auto-pay.

- ♦ When writing a check that you put in the mail, use a Uni-Ball 207 gel pen. It may help to defray white-washing.
- ♦ Do not confront anyone suspicious you might see at the mailbox, be safe and call the Police.
