Car Hijacking Awareness

Last week we had an incident in our Village where a resident was battered with life threatening injuries that sadly resulted in her death over a car hijacking that took place on the 4400 block of Natchez. The suspect was in custody within a few hours due to the Flock Cameras the Village installed last year. This allows the Police Department to enter identifying factors in the computer which is shared by many municipalities who identified the vehicle and the suspect resulting in an arrest. He is charged with aggrevated car hijacking and first degree murder. *Please keep the family in your prayers during this difficult time.*

For your safety, should you be encountered by any theft of a vehicle whether its car hijacking or catalytic converter theft DO NOT approach or attempt to fight off the suspects. Your life is more important than a piece of property. It is recommended to install ring doorbells for added protection and made available if needed by Police.

The Village offers **Safety Seminars** throughout the year to remind residents of this and other safety measures. We encourage all to attend. The next Safety Seminar takes place at our **Recreation Center of our Village Hall** on the following dates:

Dog & Cat tags are required for all pets 4 months and older. When applying, bring the rabies certificate in order to fill out the application and obtain a tag. Tags are \$2.00 ea.
