**Announces Super Bowl Weekend Enforcement Results**

Harwood Heights, IL –The Harwood Heights Police Department conducted a traffic safety campaign February 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> during the Super Bowl Weekend reminding motorists to buckle up and drive sober. The goal was to keep impaired drivers off the roads and ensure more people buckle up and follow all traffic safety laws.

During the Super Bowl Enforcement Campaign, Harwood Heights officers worked an additional 17 hours of patrol taking the following enforcement actions:

- Conducted 18 traffic stops
- Arrested 1 driver for DUI
- Arrested 1 driver for a suspended license (DUI Related)
- Cited 6 seat belt violators
- Cited 1 distracted driver
- Issued 14 other various traffic violation citations

“Motorists should understand that we are serious about cracking down on impaired drivers and seat belt and other traffic safety law violators. We do it to save lives,” said Sergeant Nick Ramirez.

The Super Bowl campaign was made possible by federal highway safety funds administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation as part of the statewide “Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over” and “Click It or Ticket” campaigns.
