Pet Etiquette

Reminder to keep pets on a leash when walking them and respect your neighbors by picking up after them placing their feces in **your own trash container**! If feces from your pets are not picked up, they are a source of food for rodents. So clean up after your pets. Tickets will be issued if not followed.

Rodent Control

It is important that your refuse containers are closed at all times, especially during these warm months!

Follow proper use of bird feeders and change water frequently to avoid mosquitoes. Do NOT leave food for them on the grass or concrete. We don't want to feed the rodents.
