Snow Information:

Snow Ban and Snow Parking Regulations

When snow reaches 2" or more, parking restrictions shall be in effect from 8:00am to 4:00pm

On even-numbered dates of the month, there is no parking allowed on the even-numbered side of the street. On odd-numbered dates, there is no parking on the odd-numbered side of the street.

Do NOT blow or shovel snow onto the streets.
