
10.52.150 Parking restrictions during snow removal operations.

- A. At any such time that the police department or the department of public works determines that the level of falling snow has reached a depth of two inches or more, the parking restrictions contained herein shall be in effect from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. On even-numbered dates of the month, no parking, standing or loading shall be allowed on the even-numbered side of the street. On odd-numbered dates of the month, no parking standing or loading shall be allowed on the odd-numbered side of the street.
- B. Any person, firm, or corporation which parks, or causes to be parked, a motor vehicle in violation of the provision herein shall be fined in accordance with the fine schedule appended to this code as Appendix 2.
- C. In addition to the penalty set forth above, any vehicle which blocks access to a street so as to impede the reasonable and efficient removal of snow shall be towed at the owner's expense.
- D. No person found to be in violation of the provisions herein shall have a cause of action for damages resulting from, or arising out of, being towed or plowed in.
