ORDINANCE NO. 24 - 02

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF HARWOOD HEIGHTS 2014 Ford Explorer - ("VIN") 1FM5K8AR0EGB27305

WHEREAS, the Village of Harwood Heights (hereinafter, "the Village") is a home rule unit of government pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Illinois Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Village, as a home rule unit of government, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Harwood Heights is authorized by Section 11-76-4 of the Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, to sell/dispose of surplus property in any manner approved by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of a majority of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Harwood Heights that it is no longer necessary, useful to, or in the best interest of the Village to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described in Exhibit A hereto; and

WHEREAS, disposing of the personal property described in Exhibit A in the manner hereinafter set forth is hereby deemed to be the most efficient use of Village resources and that conducting such a disposal is in the public interest;

WHEREAS; it has been determined by the Corporate Authorities that the personal property described in Exhibit A shall be donated to the Norwood Park Fire District for their use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Harwood Heights, County of Cook, Illinois, in the exercise of the Village's home rule powers, as follows:

SECTION 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as is fully set forth in the Section 1.

SECTION 2. Title. This Ordinance shall be known and may hereafter be referred to as the *Disposal of Surplus Motor Vehicle Ordinance*.

SECTION 3. Enactment. Pursuant to its home rule powers and Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11 – 76-4, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Harwood Heights find the personal property described more particularly in the attached Exhibit A, now owned by the Village of Harwood Heights, is no longer necessary or useful to the Village of Harwood Heights and that the best interests of the Village will be served by donating such personal property to the Norwood Park Fire District for their use.

The Corporate Authorities hereby authorize and direct Village of Harwood
Heights Public Works Superintendent Ron Maslo to donate the personal property set
forth in Exhibit A in an "as-is" condition, without warranty, to the Norwood Park Fire
District for their use.

SECTION 4. Resolution of Conflicts. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. Saving Clause. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance, which are hereby declared to be separable.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
