

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WHEREAS, the Village of Harwood Heights (the “Village”) is an Illinois municipal corporation organized and operating pursuant to authority granted by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Illinois;

WHEREAS, the Village is a home rule unit of government pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Illinois Constitution;

WHEREAS, pursuant to its home rule power, the Village may exercise any power and perform any function relating to its government and affairs;

WHEREAS, the Village is authorized to regulate the use of its streets and other Village property (65 ILCS 5/11-80-2), and regulate the standing or parking of vehicles with respect to streets and highways under its jurisdiction (625 ILCS 5/11-208(a)(1)); and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village desire to amend the regulations limiting the duration of street parking for certain vehicle classes in the Village of Harwood Heights Municipal Code (“*Village Code*”) to prevent Second Division, Class C (and larger) vehicles, meaning those with a GVWR (Gross Vehicle Weight Rating) of 8,000 pounds or more, from standing or parking on commercial and residential streets in the Village for longer than 60 minutes at a time; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village find that amending the Village Code, as provided in this Ordinance, is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of Village residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Harwood Heights, County of Cook, Illinois, in the exercise of the Village's home rule powers, Title 10 ("Vehicles and Traffic"), Chapter 10.52 ("Stopping, Standing and Parking"), Section 10.52.130 ("Parking of Trucks Restricted") of the Harwood Heights Code of Ordinances be amended as follows:

SECTION 1. That the recitals set forth above be and the same are hereby incorporated as though set forth fully in this Section 1.

SECTION 2. Amendment. Title 10 ("Vehicles and Traffic"), Chapter 10.52 ("Stopping, Standing and Parking"), Section 10.52.130 ("Parking of Trucks Restricted") of the Harwood Heights Code of Ordinances shall be, and hereby is amended as follows (deletions ~~bold and strikethrough~~, additions in **bold and underline**):

10.52.130 Parking of trucks restricted.

...

- B. No person shall stand or park any second division motor vehicle with a registration of "**DC**" or larger on any business or residential street in the village for a longer period than sixty (60) minutes or for such time as is necessary for the reasonably expeditious loading or unloading of such vehicle or such time required during the day to complete work supported by the motor vehicle.

SECTION 3. RESOLUTION OF CONFLICTS. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. SAVING CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other

provisions of this Ordinance, which are hereby declared to be separable.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.






